



## How do I form a Union at my workplace?

The process to form a Union at your workplace is relatively simple.

Here are four common steps to form or join a Union at your workplace:

1. Talk with your co-workers. Find out if there is support for joining a Union amongst the group. This will be important when your group begins the formal organizing process.

2. Seek out and speak with a Union organizer.

3. Continue to speak with your co-workers. If the employer opposes the group joining a Union, there will be opposition to the effort.

4. Show your support for the Union through an Election or Card-Check. A simple majority (50% plus one) is all it takes to prevail.
